## What is the MnLINK Gateway?

The Minnesota Library Information Network, MnLINK, is a virtual library that links you electronically to Minnesota's rich information resources. The MnLINK Gateway provides access to library catalogs, full-text articles and more to put trusted information in your hands. These participating libraries have agreed to share their resources with Minnesotans and include the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities (MnPALS), the University of Minnesota, Minnesota's public library systems, public libraries, state government, private colleges, K-12 schools, and special libraries.

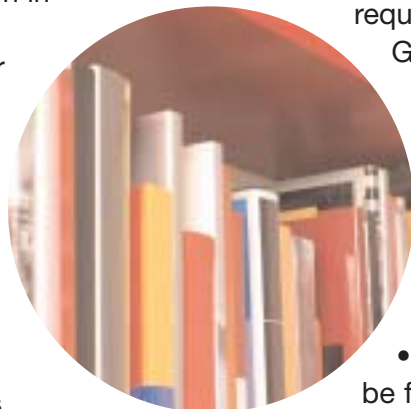
- Access the MnLINK Gateway from your library, home or office.
- Search multiple libraries and databases at once.
- Request materials.
- Search the Electronic Library for Minnesota (ELM) to view and download articles about numerous topics.

## Using the MnLINK Gateway

Access to the MnLINK Gateway is free and available to anyone by visiting:

- You must be a registered user of a participating Minnesota library to request materials through the MnLINK Gateway.
- Visit your local library to get your library card today!
- With your current Minnesota library card you can also sign in to use ELM.
- Information about your library can be found by clicking on the  next to the library name on the search screen.
- Requests placed through the MnLINK Gateway are managed by the individual libraries. Use of the MnLINK Gateway is governed by local library policies. **Contact your local library when issues arise regarding your requests.**
- Check your local library online catalog for quicker access to materials before using the MnLINK Gateway.



## “Get it!” – Easy as 1, 2, 3

**1. Sign In to the MnLINK Gateway to request materials that are not available at your library.**



**2. Start your search.**



**3. Click on Get it! to generate a request.**

### What happens next?

- Your request is automatically routed to locations where the item is available, most requests are filled within two weeks.
- You can check the status of your request online by signing in and selecting “My Requests” on the blue navigation bar.
